I have only recently come to Corbridge and I have attempted to gather together the information that is available. Clergy receive a large number of requests for information, and, sadly, we cannot spend our time searching for individual names on gravestones. However I do hope that this information is helpful to you in your search.

GRAVEYARDS

a .St Andrews

this was closed in 1870, and since then there have been no interments , save that of cremated remains in The Garden of Rest. it is in the care of the local authority. There are no maps of the graves therein that I am aware of .

b. Halton Chapel –churchyard closed, no maps of graves

c. St. James' ,Lower Newton. Upper churchyard closed –no map; lower churchyard is open. The building itself is no longer a parish church

d. Local authority cemetery at Corbridge, for which the church has no records or information.
