

# St Andrew's 1350th



In October we will begin a year-long celebration of an amazing anniversary. St Andrew's Church will be 1350 years old.

#### What will happen during our celebration?

We hope the year will celebrate Corbridge as the community that has grown around St Andrew's Church. So, our schools, village groups and organisations are invited to share in this once in a generation anniversary.

We keep St Wilfrid's Day on October 12th, the day of his death. The opening weekend will be Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th October.
